The melody is stated in the A section. The first time through the melody (meas 1-8) shows the basic melody. The next section (meas. 9-16) gives the melody with some harmony notes, based on the chord structure.

The B section (meas. 17 - 24) is another melody, and has melody and harmony.

Then, back to the A section (meas.25 - 32) which has arpeggios between the melody notes.

Meas. 33 modulates to the key of C, with a "transition" arpeggio in meas. 32 that leads into the new key.)
