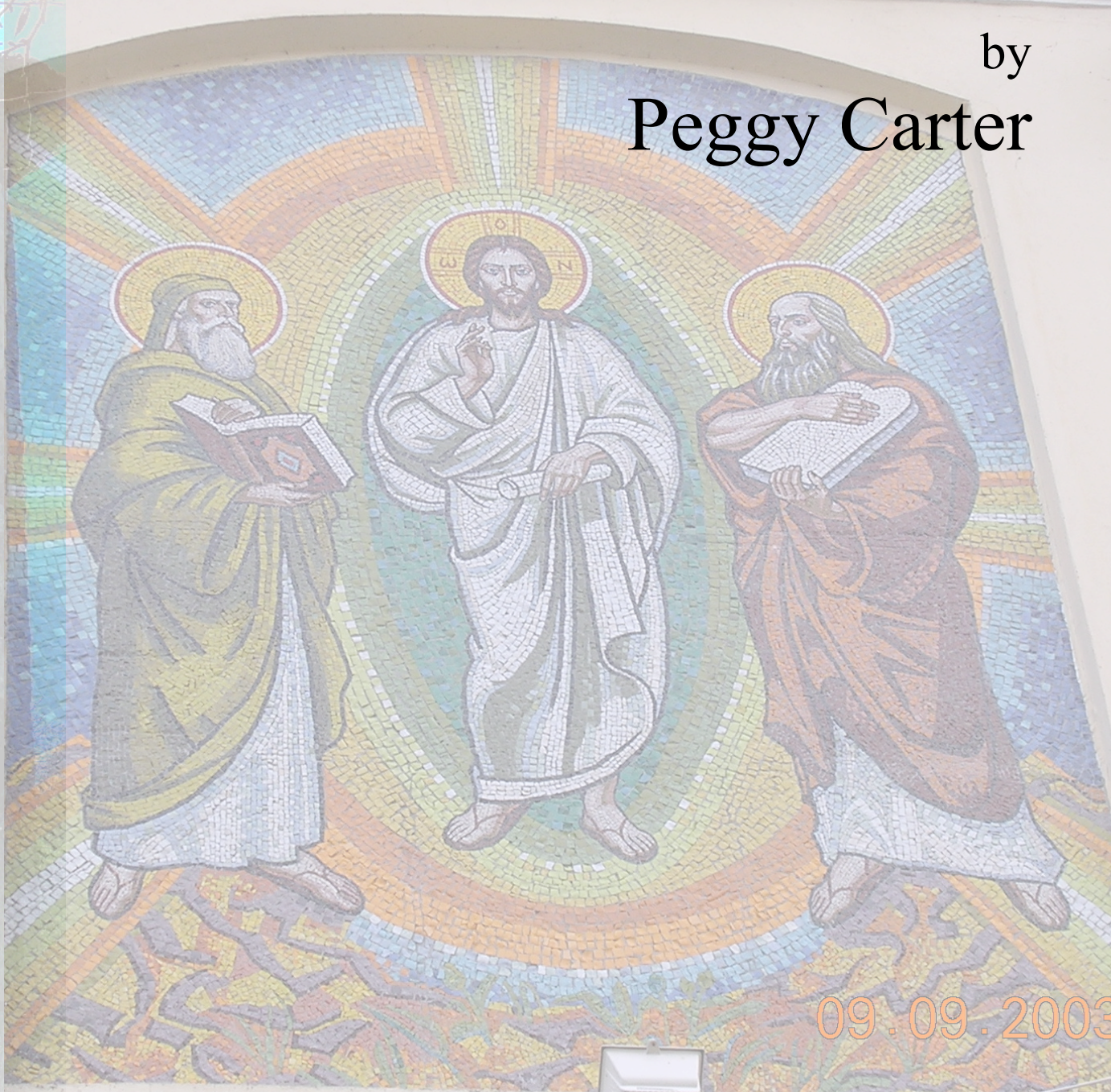

# Thine O Lord

## Old Testament Lessons : A Canticle of Worship

I Chronicles 28 and 29 relates the history of the building of the temple by King Solomon. When the temple was dedicated King David (Solomon's father who was still living at the time) gave a Psalm of praise which is recorded in I Chron. 29:10-15.

Key verses are:

*Thine, O Lord is the greatness and the power and the glory and the victory and the majesty, indeed everything that is in the heavens and the earth; Thine is the dominion, O Lord, and Thou dost exalt Thyself as head over all.*

*Both riches and honor come from Thee, and Thou dost rule over all, and in Thy hand is power and might, and it lies in Thy hand to make great and to strengthen everyone.*

*Now therefore, our God, we thank Thee and praise Thy glorious name, for all things come from Thee.*

*I Chron. 29:11-13*

When the Ark of the Covenant was brought into the Temple and placed in the Holy-of-Holies, the scene is described here –

*And it came to pass when the priests came out of the Holy-of-Holies, and the Levites who were the singers stood at the east end of the altar, clothed in white linen, having cymbals, stringed instruments and harps, and with them one hundred and twenty priests sounding with trumpets – indeed it came to pass when the trumpeters and singers were as one to make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the Lord, and when they lifted up their voice with the trumpets and cymbals and instruments of music, that the house of the Lord was filled with a cloud, so that the priests could not continue ministering because of the cloud; for the glory of the Lord filled the House of God.*


